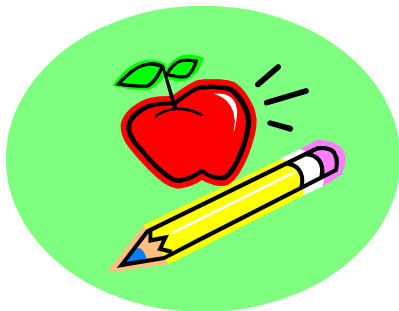

We are excited to have your four year old. Character building is the main focus the first month, we are teaching the children to be peacemakers and kind to others.

Parents please encourage your child to 1) ask the other student to stop 2) tell the Teacher, or any other adult 3) walk away from the situation 4) tell you (the parent) what happens daily.

They can show kindness by offering a friend the seat next to them, asking the new child to play, and comfort others when crying or upset.

Kindergarten

Spelling Bee lists have been sent home. Please take the time to review and read over the words with your child.

To make this list exciting for your child, make flashcards, stick the list to the refrigerator, and do rhythm games.

The children have adjusted well. The first three weeks we will review the four year old curriculum; including phonics, numbers, neatly writing, focusing on letter formation.

Sign In/Out Daily

Parents it is very important that you sign your children in and out daily. Your four digit code is confidential; only give it to those you trust.

The children may not clock themselves in or out. This ensures accuracy, as well as a safety precaution when dealing with a computer on a high stand.

Parents, please walk your children all the way into the building. Besides signing them in, you ensure their safety.
